Describe the contribution of alumni association to the institution within a maximum of 500 words

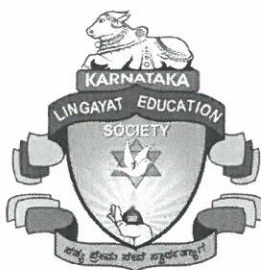

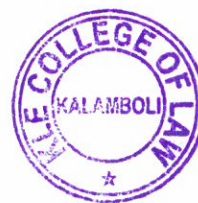
Description of the event:

Event Outcomes:

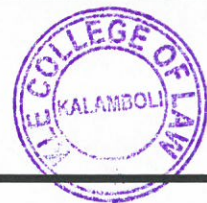

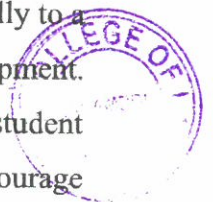

Definitions:

- The "Association" means the Alumni Association of KLE Society's College of Law, Navi Mumbai
- The "General Body" means the General Body of the Association.
- The "Governing Body" means the Executive Committee of the Association.
- Alumnus means an ex-student of the College, who has obtained a degree from KLE Society's College of Law, Navi Mumbai.
- An "honorary member" means any person other than an Alumnus, who has been elected by the General Body of the Association.
- The financial year of the Association shall be reckoned every year from 1st April to 31st March of the following year.

Patrons:

- The Association may have Patrons as approved by the Governing Body, provided that a patron shall be an out-standing professional. Such appointment being for a period of one year.
- The Principal of KLE Society's College of Law shall be an ex-officio Patron of the Alumni Association.

Membership:

- Any student who successfully obtains any degree (BLS LL.B., 3Year LL.B., LL.M) from the College automatically becomes a Life member of the Association from the date of issue of the Result Notification granting the said degree on payment of the appropriate membership fees as prescribed by the association.
- The membership fee in respect of all the members and would be decided by mutual discussions in AGM every year. The mode of collection of the membership fees would be decided from time to time in mutual discussions in AGM every year.

Procedure:

- The Governing Body shall determine the expenditure, which is necessary to carry on the affairs of the Association and is authorized to incur such expenditure. In this connection, within 15 days of the Annual General Body meeting, a meeting of the Governing Body will be held in which a proforma of major activities for the coming year will be discussed and finalized, including budgetary allocation. Committee and General Body Meetings shall be recorded in a Minutes Book maintained for the purpose.

Amendments to the Constitution:
